Rare Dementia Support Canada: Peoples, Spaces, Places (2024-2027)

RDS Canada is a new and growing support community for individuals and families affected by a rare dementia diagnosis that complements traditional dementia care services by providing tailored (e.g., age, diagnosis and stage) and continuous support, as well as educational outreach to practitioners to increase their capacity to provide inclusive dementia services. To further localize this model and extend its reach within Canada, including support to diverse peoples and diverse families who are living in diverse landscapes, we will evaluate what support is working for whom, when and how, to further understand RDS Canada's impact on individual and family well-being. We will also generate learnings on how best to provide centralized specialist support alongside local general support for people living in varied regions across Canada. Our intended outcomes are instrumental for growing national and global communities of support for people living with dementia.
